A wine only produced in exceptional vintages, the White Rose Estate 2006 is a single-vineyard bottling from the vineyard we have built our winery around- White Rose Vineyard. Planted in 1980, White Rose Vineyard has earned the reputation as one of the premier vineyards in Oregon. The vineyard is planted with own-rooted Pommard clone pinot and ranges in elevation from just under 900ft- 750ft on east facing Jory soils. Meticulous farming with yields of 1 ton/acre creates intense flavors and complex aromatics.
